ASSOCIATION BYLAWS

Date: October 14, 1986

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3(b) of the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of the Sully Station Community Association states that "the Board of Trustees shall have all powers for the conduct of the affairs of the Association which are enabled by law or the Founding Documents which are not specifically reserved to members or the Developer by said Documents;" and

WHEREAS, the Developer, Sully Station Associates, has prepared Bylaws which provide detailed guidelines and procedures for the governance and operation of the Sully Station Community Association; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to adopt such Bylaws in order to permit the orderly and effective execution of its duties, powers and responsibilities;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Board of Trustees hereby adopts the Bylaws for the Sully Station Community Association prepared by the Developer and dated October 14, 1986, such action being subject to any future technical corrections or amendments which might be required by the County of Fairfax, Virginia, the Veterans Administration or other agencies or institutions having review and approval authority with respect to the Bylaws.
